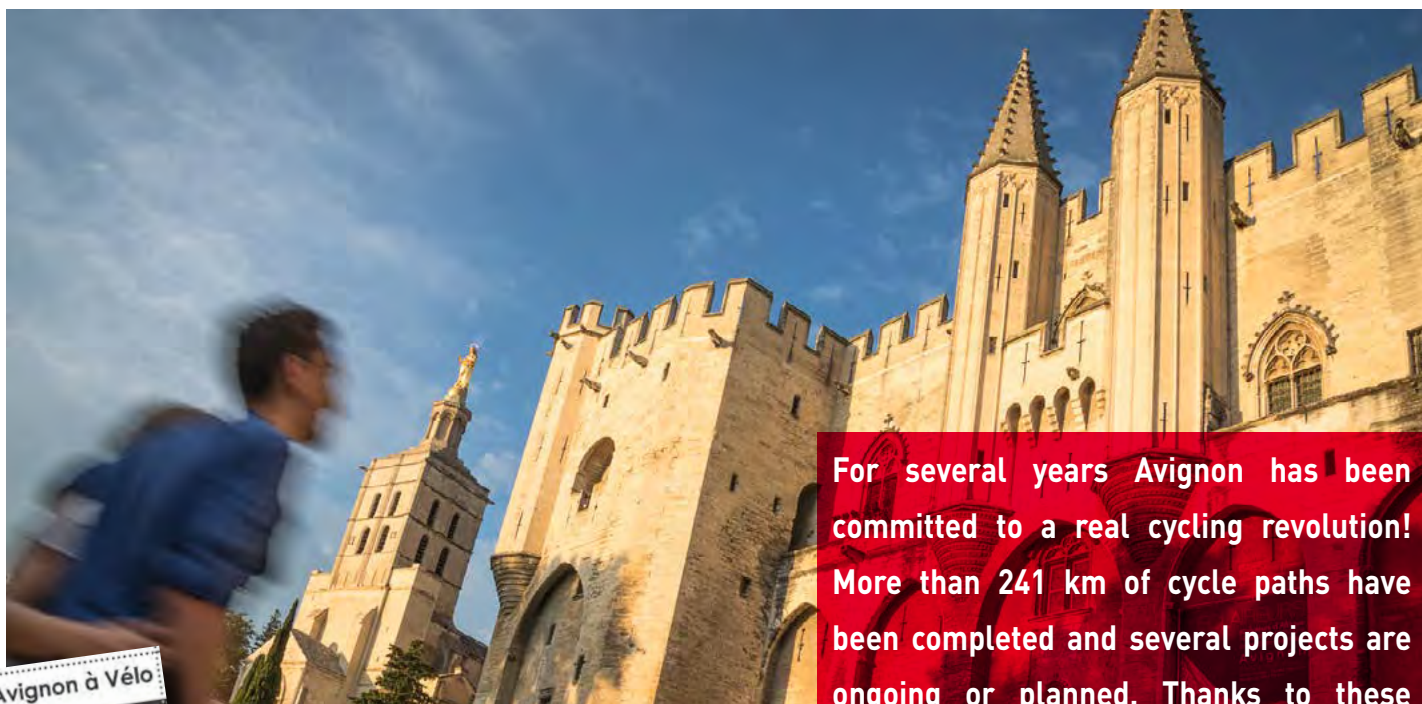

SAFETY AND NATURE FIRST

While you ride, please respect the highway code as well as the fauna and flora of Avignon!

Please give priority to pedestrians at all times. The historic centre of Avignon within the ramparts is a pedestrian zone, where the speed limit is 20 km/h for all. Cyclists are allowed to ride against the direction of traffic. Only children under the age of 8 are allowed to ride on the pavement. Find all the regulations relating to cycling at

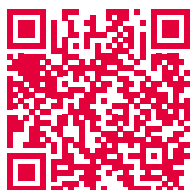

Want to discover Avignon's heritage from a different angle?

ALL AROUND THE RAMPARTS

Approx. 45 min (not including stops) - 4.3 km - very easy - flat.
Most of the ride is on greenways and part on shared roads (mixed-use zone inside the ramparts).

Visit the countryside in the town! Whether between the fields and orchards of the Barthelasse island, or through the agricultural landscape of Montfavet, discover Avignon's countryside with these two walks on the outskirts of the town.



BARTHELASSE ISLAND

« 100% relaxing bike ride in a green setting near the historic city centre! »

1h30 - approx. 13 km - easy - flat.

THE MONTFAVET CIRCUIT



« A 19km circuit between town and fields, along the canals! »

2h30 - about 20 km - easy - flat.

« Montfavet trail – Drylands and Wetland meadows »

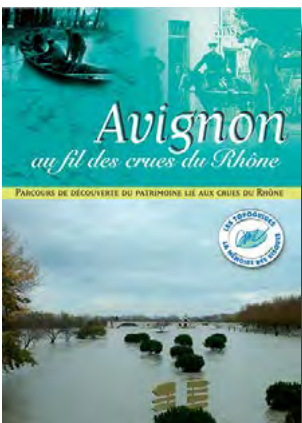

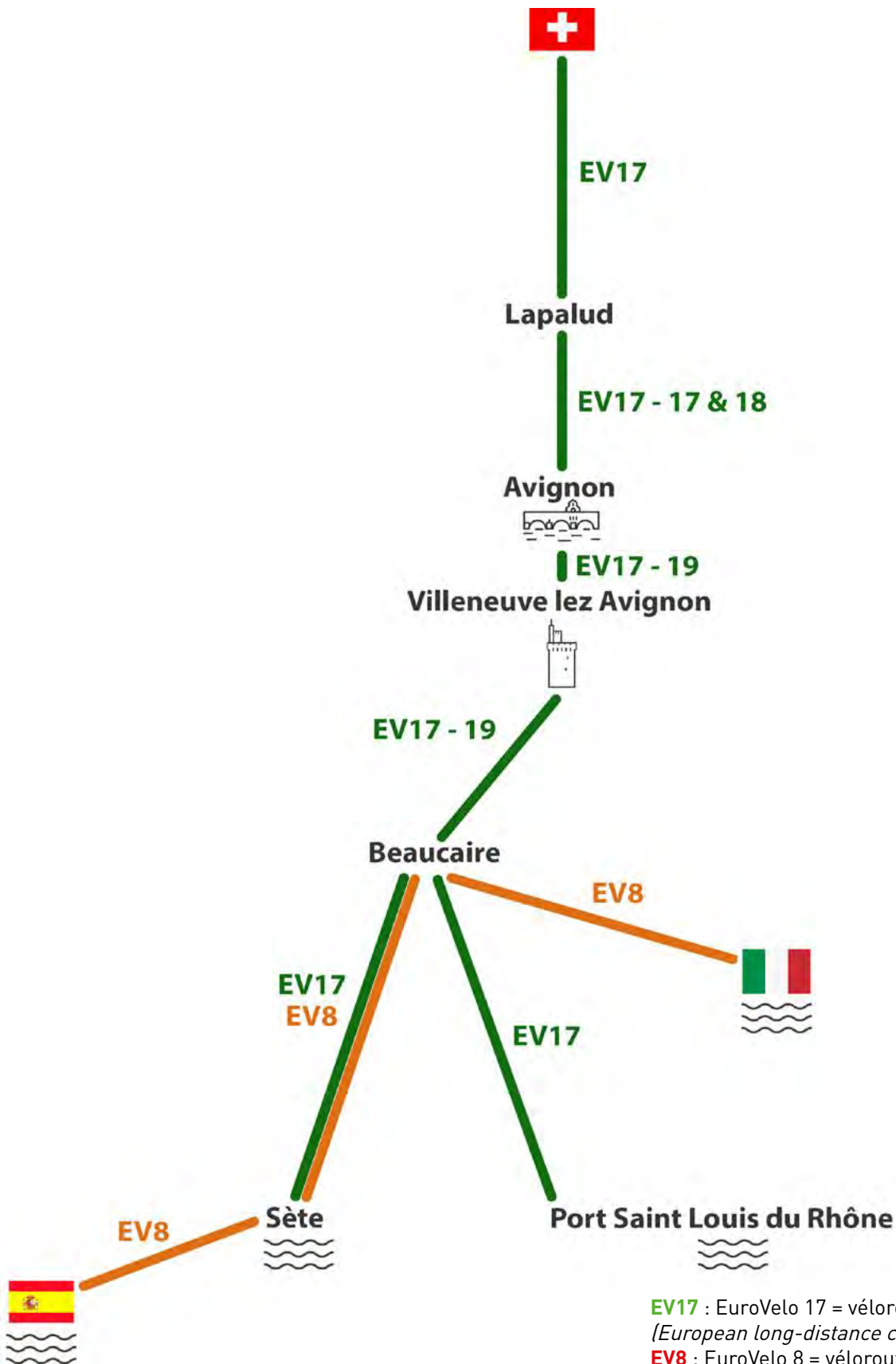

4 - LONG DISTANCE CYCLING ROUTES & AVIGNON






How about choosing slow travel this year? Avignon can be reached directly by bike from three European countries, and it is right on the long-distance cycling routes to the sun, between the sea and the mountains. Take the time to discover Avignon and its region and explore the south of France by bike. The Mediterranean is never far!

AVIGNON FROM SWITZERLAND:

VIARHÔNA – EV17

At 815 km long, the ViaRhôna is made up of 25 stages and stretches from Lake Geneva to the Mediterranean Sea. Discover diverse landscapes, heritage, and cultural and gastronomic traditions, all while travelling on cycle paths and quiet country roads.



Lake Geneva > Mediterranean Sea - 815 km
Easy to challenging – cycle paths and shared roads

The Viarhônga in figures:

- 65% of the route directly next to the Rhône
- 3% incline
- 30 train stations along the route
- 3 regional natural parks
- 3 Unesco listed cities: Avignon, Arles, Lyon



Avignon lies at the confluence of two stretches of the ViaRhônga, being the first big town on the route after Lyon and the final stretch to the sea!

Coming from the mountains and Lyon: **étape 18** Caderousse > Avignon – 36 km

En route for the sea: **étape 19** Avignon > Beaucaire – 38 km

AVIGNON, BETWEEN SPAIN AND ITALY:

MEDITERRANEAN CYCLE ROUTE - EV8

Discover the Mediterranean basin by bike on the long-distance Mediterranean Cycle Route, which passes through France from Spain to Italy, joining the Pyrenees to the Alps. With mountains, lakes, marshes, canals and outstanding heritage left by the Roman Empire, experience the Mediterranean differently!



Le Perthus > Menton – 850 km

Easy to experienced– cycle paths and small roads

Coming to Avignon by bike means taking full advantage to also explore Provence and see its famous landscapes of olive groves, lavender fields, sunflowers and poppies, but also its hilltop villages, and ranges like the Dentelles de Montmirail, Mont Ventoux and Luberon. There are varied landscapes, relief and altitudes around Avignon, so there are circuits for all levels, choose your route!

A DAY TRIP FROM AVIGNON

PONT DU GARD – approx. 35 km (one way)

When winter arrives, it's time to get on your bike and (re)discover the Camargue. Its marshes, its infinite skies and its thousands of birds, including the famous grey cranes.

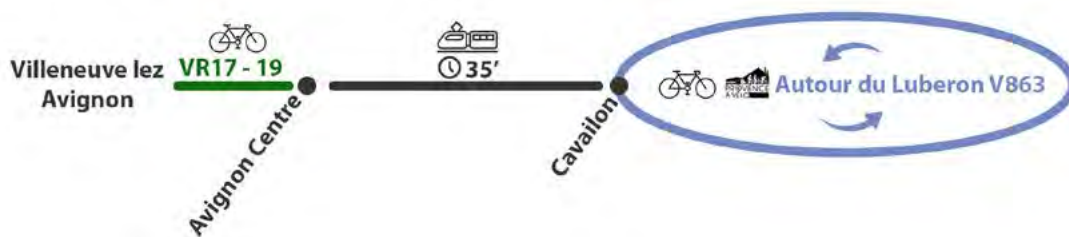

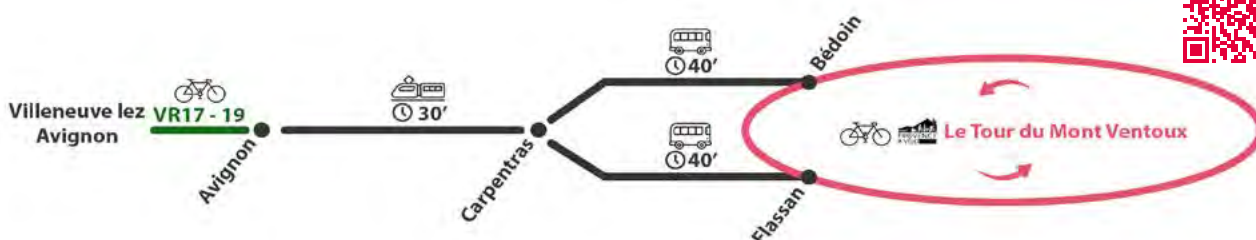

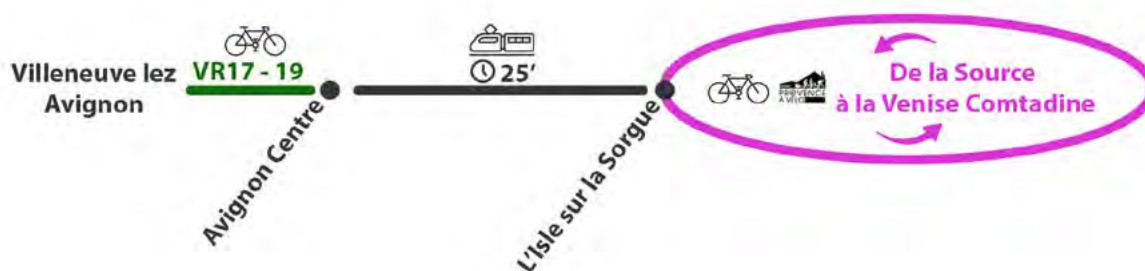

In high-speed trains (TGV), it is possible to travel with a folded bike in its case (reservation not required, no additional charge).
